Additional responsibilities may be available to a suitably qualified candidate.

#### QUALITIES & EXPERIENCE SOUGHT

- A good honours degree and UK teaching qualification in **English**
- Experience of current UK teaching methods and knowledge of UK examination standards
- A record, supported by references, which would provide evidence of the following strengths:
  - Experience and proven success in **English Language and Literature** teaching to a high academic standard, including A-level or IB
  - Enthusiastic contribution to the development of department and whole-school initiatives
  - Innovative teaching methods, including the use of digital technologies to support teaching and learning
  - Commitment to pastoral care of pupils and extracurricular activities
  - Commitment to continuing professional development
- A spirit of initiative and an enthusiasm for taking on new tasks
- An interest in bilingualism and bilingual education
- The ability to develop and maintain constructive relationships – with teaching and administrative colleagues, students and parents – in a complex international educational community
- Experience of Sixth Form tutoring and University Entrance would be advantageous

Lack of fluency in French should not discourage teachers from applying, though candidates must be willing to work towards attaining functional fluency.

## SALARY & BENEFITS

- Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The British Section operates its own independent salary scale, which is highly competitive with schools in the UK and locally
- Relocation assistance will be provided, including removal expenses and contribution to the cost of French language tuition if required
- The employment contract will be **full-time** and **permanent** (a French *contrat à durée indéterminée*). All employees of the British Section contribute towards a French state pension and two supplementary pension plans
- The children of teaching staff may be enrolled in the school if they meet the academic conditions of entry
