

Core curriculum

- French Literature (Year 12 only) : 4 h
- Philosophy (Year 13 only) : 4 h
- Foreign Language A & Foreign Language B: 6h00
- Science: 2 h
- Sport: 2 h
- Civic education: 18 hours per year



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Assessment method: Continuous assessment (*Contrôle continu*)

- Aggregate of 3 anonymised tests
 - 2 in Year 12
 - 1 in Year 13
- Marks from termly reports
 - coefficient 10/120 (all subjects)



Assessment method: **French & Philosophy**

- French Literature: written and oral exams
 - end Year 12
- Philosophy: written exam
 - end Year 13



LA PREMIÈRE ET LA TERMINALE EN VOIE GÉNÉRALE

Special/depth subjects (enseignements de spécialité)

■ Students choose 3 in Year 12 (4h per week per subject) and reduce to 2 in Year 13 (6h per week per subject) from the list below:

- Maths
- IT
- Physics/Chemistry
- Biology & Geology
- Social and Economic Sciences
- History, Geography & Political Sciences
- Humanities, Literature & Philosophie
- Foreign Language and Literature



Assessment method: Final examinations (*Epreuves finales*)

- Written exams
 - after Easter holidays, Year 13
- Oral exam
 - June, Year 13
- Coefficient: 16/120 for each special subject examined in Year 13



OIB subjects

- English Language and Literature: 4 h
- History-Geography:
 - 4 h in English
 - 2 h in French



Assessment method: Final examination

- Written & oral exams in both subjects in Year 13
(timing of exams to be confirmed in due course)
- Coefficient $15 + 15 = 30/120$ (25% of total mark)



Assessment calendar

■ Year 12

- 2 sessions of continuous assessment tests in core curriculum
- Examinations (written & oral) in French Literature (June)
- Examination in special subject student will drop in Year 13

■ Year 13

- 1 session of continuous assessment tests in core curriculum
- OIB exams (English Lit & History-Geo), written & oral
- Written exams in special subjects (after Easter holidays)
- Oral examination (June)
- Philosophy written examination (June)
