JOB SUMMARY

The British Section – the largest of 14 national sections forming the Lycée International, one of France’s most successful and respected schools – is seeking a Temporary Full-time and Primary English Teacher to join our Primary Department starting in November 2023 to cover maternity leave. Each Full-time Primary Teacher teaches 3 classes. The maternity leave post is for CE1, CE2 and CM1. Part-time or job share may be available, depending on applicants’ availability.

QUALITIES & EXPERIENCE SOUGHT

- A native English speaker
- A good honours degree and UK teaching qualification
- Experience of current UK teaching methods from EYFS to KS2, and knowledge of UK assessment standards
- Carte de séjour or a European nationality with the right to work in France
- A record, supported by references, which would provide evidence of the following strengths:
 - Inspirational classroom teaching
 - Keen interest in the teaching and learning of literacy skills (including good knowledge of children’s literature as a source of stimulus material)
 - The ability to design tasks which stretch the academically gifted and support those with special educational needs
 - Enthusiastic contribution to the development of department and whole-school initiatives e.g. curriculum planning, pupil assessment etc.
 - Commitment to continuing professional development
 - Use of formative assessment to respond to the individual needs of pupils
 - Innovative use of digital technologies to support teaching and learning

- Commitment to pastoral care of pupils and extracurricular activities
- An interest in bilingualism and experience of EAL would be advantageous
- Ability to develop and maintain constructive relationships - with teaching and administrative colleagues, students and parents - in a complex international educational community

SALARY & BENEFITS

- Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The British Section operates its own independent salary scale, which is highly competitive with schools in the UK and locally
- The employment contract will be **temporary** (a French *contrat à durée déterminée*). All employees of the British Section contribute towards a French state pension and two supplementary pension plans

GOVERNANCE

British Section teachers and administrative staff are employed by the British Section Parents' Association (BSPA) which is a French non-profit making Association. The BSPA's Governing Body (largely comprising elected parents with input from an independent governor and former Head Teacher) oversees the management of the BSPA's affairs (by the Senior Leadership Team led by the Director) and its annual budget. All appointments must be formally approved by the French administration.
