

## Français Spécial

- Immersion in FRENCH
  - 80% of the curriculum is in French
  - One-year bridging programme
  - Lingua Franca!
- Aptitude tests with a French teacher after the British Section has tested the pupil and recommended them as a Français Spécial candidate



## The British Section in Primary

- 6 hours per week (20% of curricular time) NOT immersion (3 hours in Maternelle 1)
- One morning and one afternoon session per week
- First language English curriculum
- Designed for students with a strong background, regular use and ongoing support in English



#### Teaching & Learning in Primary

6 hours per week, developing the key skills of

- Listening
- Speaking
- Reading
- Writing

We follow a book-based topic curriculum using poetry, prose and drama, as stimulus material.

We develop historical skills, using story-telling from the maternelle onwards, culminating in a study of the Second World War in CM2.

## A lively department with a British teaching style, we focus on the whole child to:

- Provide an environment which is physically and emotionally secure and intellectually stimulating
- Understand and foster the learning process



## Parental Support

- Parental effort is required in a persistent and consistent manner regardless of the child's language profile
- Age-appropriate ability in speaking, listening, reading and writing in English, and the potential and support to maintain development of these skills whilst being educated in a primarily francophone environment
- All pupils require sustained exposure to English
- Family language planning



## Steps in the Application Process

- British Section website: britishsection.fr
- Pay application fee on HelloAsso site (160€ Maternelle, 200€ Primary)
- Complete online application form (sent after payment received)
- Appointment for test sent by email
- Tests in person in March (May for Maternelle 1)
- E-mail from BS with test results (April / May)
- Recommendation to French administration
- Paperwork will follow, please complete this by return of post, if possible. This could be May / June
- If your child is accepted, there is a one-off payment of 2000€ Child Admission Fee

## **Entrance Interviews**

- Mat 1- CE2 Individual testing
- CM1 and CM2 Individual testing within a group environment
- Mat 1 CP Use of picture texts to stimulate language
- CE1 and CE2 Creative Writing task
- Reading exercise
- Comprehension and spelling exercise
- CM1 and CM2 Creative Writing task
- Comprehension and spelling
- Our aim is to enable the children to feel relaxed and secure so that they can use their language skills freely.
